Plickers is a free card activity that you AND your students will love ❤️. Scan the room and immediately get data in real time that you can use to meet the needs of your students! They are FREE, incredibly versatile, and low-maintenance. Use anything as answer choices – 🖼️ images, 🔊 sounds, 🎥 videos, 🎞️ GIFs, and 📐 equations. And control everything from your phone Mobile phone with remote media playback and zoom Left-pointing magnifying glass.


## Getting Started

1. Make a class and add your students. For help, read our [Getting Started Guide](#).
2. Create your first questions to ask. We recommend starting with a fun question like “Which flavor of ice cream do you like best?” See [our guide to creating questions](#).
3. Prep Plickers cards for your students. Students don’t need devices to use Plickers, but they do need Plickers cards. You can [download the PDF for free](#) or [buy cards on Amazon](#).
4. Download the Plickers app. Get the Plickers app for [iOS](#) or for [Android](#).

During COVID school closures, you can use [Plickers E-Learning](#) to allow your students to answer at home on their school devices.

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

- Quiz – this can be used to quickly identify struggling students
- Survey – this can be used to anonymously gather information about students
- as a tool to start discussions – this can pique a students interest in a topic by getting them to choose an opinion about a given topic



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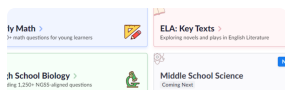

- Exit Ticket
- Formative Assessments
- Choosing Groups or Topics
- Writing Workshop Status of the Class
- Complete story review by posting multiple choice questions about whole class stories/novels read
- Review genre details by matching characteristics of each genre you display
- Use it as a faster form of K-W-L by having students answer True/False questions about a story or about its background information
- Display a sentence with an underlined word and have students identify its part of speech
- Ask students to identify the preposition or prepositional phrase in a sentence
- Display a word that DOES NOT follow the particular phonics rule you're learning for that week or unit (the English language is filled with rule-breaker words!) then have students choose the description of WHY that word doesn't follow the phonics rule
- Use the True/False feature to ask if a word is spelled correctly
- Put up pictures of objects for students to match with its beginning or ending sound



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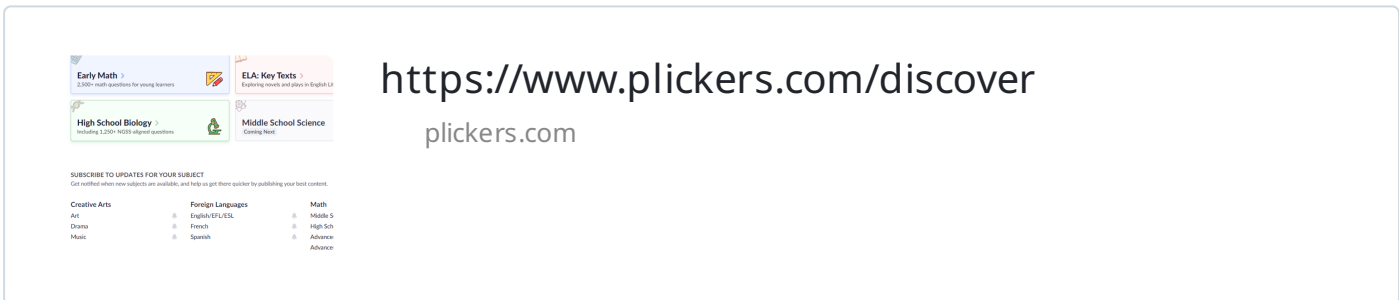

# Math

- Exit Ticket
- Formative Assessments
- Images or equations with money that students need to solve
- You can show pictures of fractions for a quick review or assessment
- Ask about math vocabulary words to match with definitions
- Add images of geometric shapes and even clocks for geometry and time review
- Plug in math equations for students to solve (works with addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division-even long division)

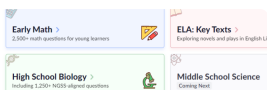
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# Other

- Take attendance
- Exit Ticket
- Choose Your Own Adventure Stories
- Parent Survey at Open House
- Student-Generated Questions
- Social/Emotional Status of the Class
- Have students pick their breakfast/lunches for the day
- Review class procedures and policies during back to school or after long holiday breaks.
- We begin using Plickers right away to learn each other's names. I post their pictures up and have students match it with the correct name.
- I feature facts about my kiddos like their favorite color, food, hobbies, etc. for other students to choose the correct answer. This builds community by showing that getting to know each other is important
- Assign a certain Plicker card number for every one of your students for the period they have you
- Staple or tape Plicker card to student folders for your class for quick and easy access=
- Laminate Plicker cards for durability purposes
- Another durability option is printing Plicker cards on cardstock



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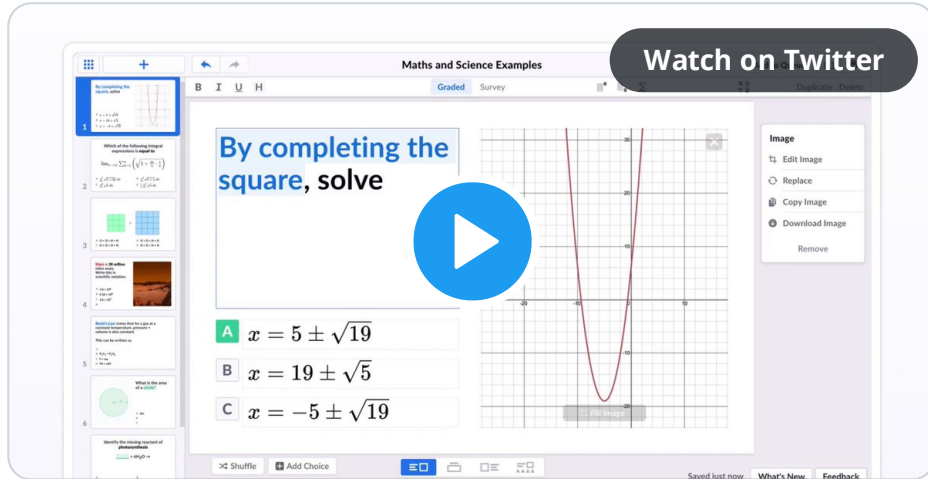


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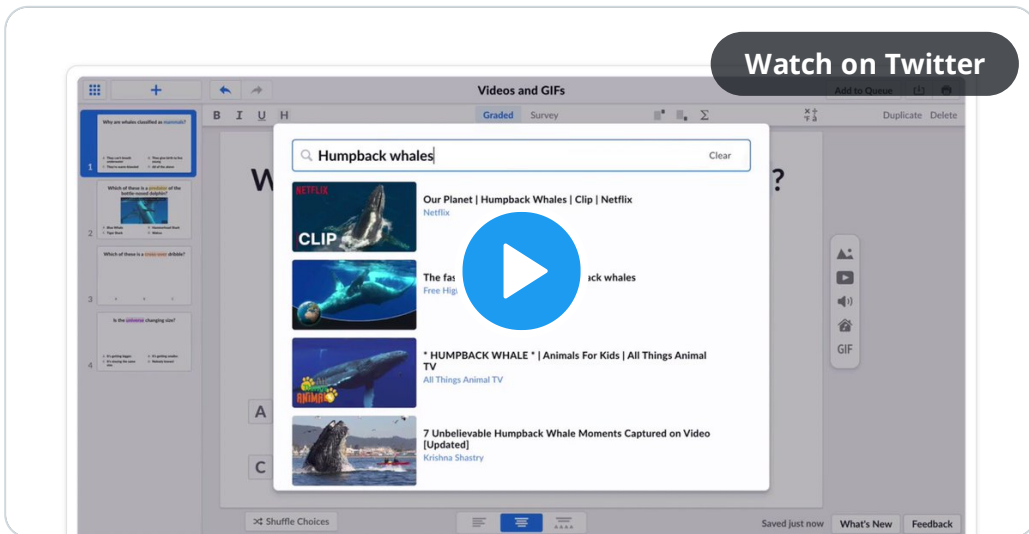
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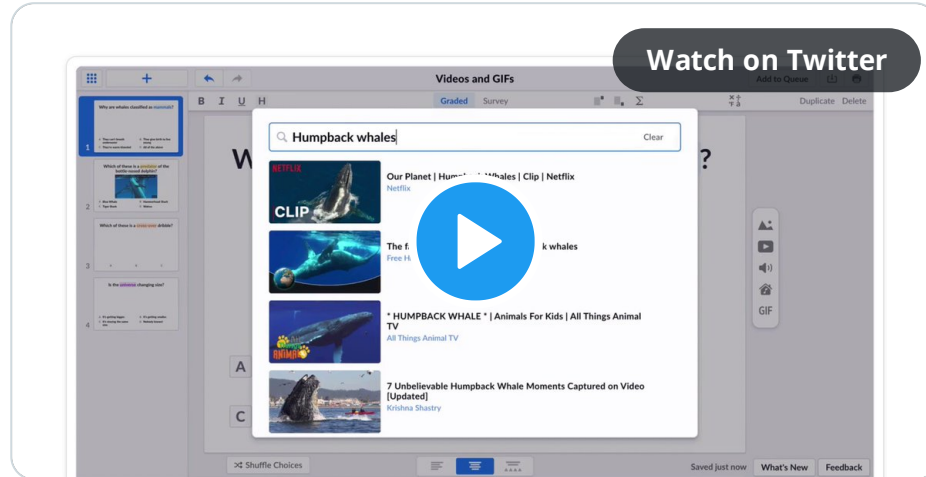


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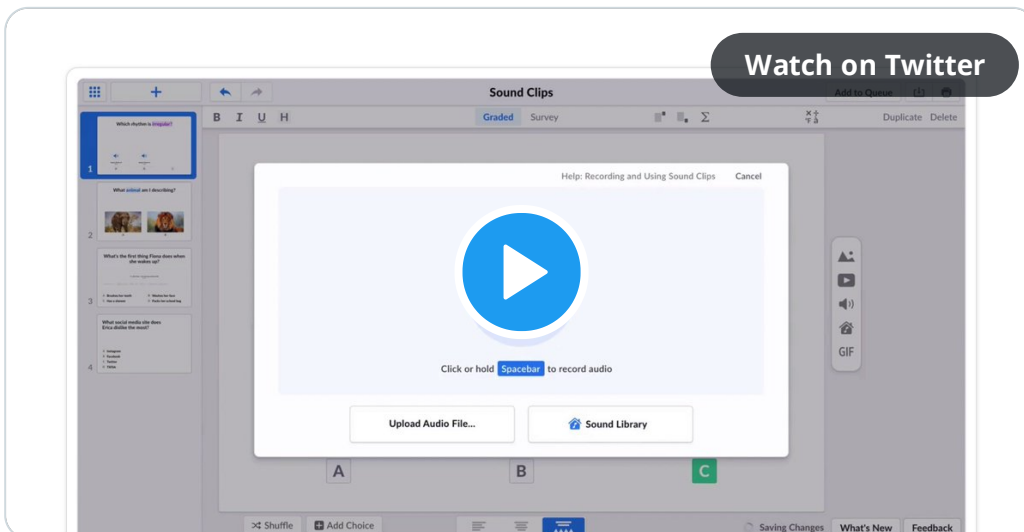
